Additional Course Costs

There are costs associated with all studies, additional to the tuition fee, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. Costs are indicative and for the total length of the course shown unless otherwise stated and will increase with inflation; depending on the programme they may include equipment, printing, project materials, study trips, placement activities, DBS and/or other security checks.

Additional course costs for BA (Hons) Dance are outlined below:

Books and other Texts

Whilst all mandatory texts are supplied in print/electronic form in the university library, learners often prefer to purchase their own copies of texts to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for learners studying on a degree course is assumed as £100 per year if individual copies are purchased.

Printing

We recommend a minimum budget of £50 per year for basic printing/photocopying costs.

Study Trips

Compulsory study tours and trips within the UK will cost between £100 and £200 per year.

Dance Uniform

Costs of around £200-£300 per year for appropriate dance uniform for ballet and jazz classes including leotards, dance tights and shoes. This may also include contributing towards dance costumes for shows.

Placement Travel

Around £100 per year travel costs associated with work-based learning placements.

Professional Body Membership

Around £50 per year and optional.

DBS Checks

These may be required for placements/ work-based learning opportunities. Around £80 initial cost and upkeep of £13 per year with subscription to the renewal service.

Public Liability Insurance for placements

For learners who choose to source their own placements at L6, they made need to purchase their own public liability insurance. This can cost around £80 for the year. For those opting for a placement organised by the university, such insurance will not be required.

Gym Membership

We highly recommend all students sign up for a gym membership with the university gym, this will cost around £150 per year.

Graduation

Graduation costs per learner are estimated at £100 - £200 total. This is an optional cost for all learners, as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.

Opportunity Modules

You can choose from a range of modules on offer, and these may incur a small cost, for example, for materials or travel to locations or work-based learning experiences. They will range from one module to another – please check the module information or ask your course team for details.
